Plan for 2026 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• By December, the Horringer Neighbourhood plan should be with west Suffolk.• We have all the information to start putting the plan together.• Planning policies are the next priority.• Next consultation will be with the village of the DRAFT plan, in the next 6/8 months.
5.	New approach to creating policies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A working group for policies is being created, to enable us to get them completed faster.• Each policy should have a headline; this should be forwarded to IP to check the wording.• Policies need to be completed by the end of January.• Some of the policies are falling into the community actions, the committee needs to separate these so we can present the community actions to the residents.• An appraisal of the conservation area in Horringer should be completed. Examples of villages that have completed this have been circulated. IP can provide this service.
6.	To discuss letter from resident <ul style="list-style-type: none">• PC - 1. Unhappy with the informal chat. Any contact should be on a formal basis.• PC - 2. Section 106 agreements, PC contacted WSC and they don't have any record of them. PC feels we should ask directly if there has been a section 106 entered into.• It would be nice to get clarity on their intentions for the land around Horringer.
7.	SEA update <p>The SEA may hold us up, once the planning policies are decided this may speed this up. The committee would like quotes to compare for public knowledge.</p>
8.	Photos update <ul style="list-style-type: none">• We have photos to use as Protection of important view. They just need to be filtered.
